RULES

- Prize money may be withheld if insufficient starters.
- Hats to B.S must be worn at all times when mounted.
- It is advised that body protectors are worn whilst jumping.
- No refunds will be given on entries
- Please do not muck out horse boxes on the field!
- All dogs must be kept on leads at ALL times.
- Please put litter in the bins provided.
- Warren Farm Stables cannot be held liable for any loss, damage or injury to persons, animals or property whilst at the show.
- Any accident or injury must be reported to the show secretary for inclusion in the accident book.
- The judges decision is final any objections should be made in writing within 30 mins of the class with a £25 deposit (refundable if upheld).
- In the event of cancellation a new date will be rearranged and pre- entries transferred, refunds can only be given when requests are made in writing prior to the new date and with 33% deducted for secretarial fees

RING 1

Start 9.30am Prompt

Judge :

CLASS 1 TACK AND TURN OUT – Open

CLASS 2 LEAD REIN BEST RIDER under 8 years lead reins must be attached to the noseband (all riders will receive a teddy bear when competing in this class)

CLASS 3 NOVICE RIDER - for riders in their first year of showing, no cantering except in individual shows

CLASS 4 BEST RIDER 12 YEARS AND UNDER - To be ridden off the lead rein

CLASS 5 BEST RIDER 16 YEARS AND UNDER -

CLASS 6 BEST RIDER OPEN

CLASS 7 VETERAN RIDER - for riders over 40 years a bottle of wine will be awarded to the winner

CLASS 8 LEAD REIN COMBINATION Riders 9 years or under

CLASS 9 FIRST RIDDEN COMBINATION Riders 12 years or under, Cantering in individual shows only

CLASS 10 BEST COMBINATION UNDER 16 YEARS no lead reins

CLASS 11 BEST COMBINATION OPEN

CHAMPIONSHIP for classes 2 - 11 1st & 2nd Prize winners to compete

RING 2

Start 9.30am

Judge : Miss C Miller

CLASS 12 HACK /RIDING HORSE for horses 4 years old or over, exceeding 153 cm

CLASS 13 SMALL HUNTER for horses 4 years old or over exceeding 148 cm but not exceeding 158 cm

CLASS 14 RIDDEN COB for horses 4 years old or over. To be shown hogged or traditional

RING 2 CONT.

CLASS 15 OPEN RIDDEN HUNTER for horses 4 years old or over exceeding 153 cms

CLASS 16 RIDDEN RETRAINED RACEHORSE

CLASS 17 RIDDEN COLOURED 4 years or over, to be judged on conformation, manners and turn out.

CLASS 18 RIDDEN PART BRED ARAB OR WELSH 4 years or over to be judged on conformation, manners and turn out.

CLASS 19 SHOW PONY / SHOW HUNTER 4 years old or over, Not to exceed 153cm

CLASS 20 RIDDEN FOREIGN BREEDS Open to any breeds native to countries outside the UK

CLASS 21 RIDDEN VETERAN 15 - 20 Years

CLASS 22 RIDDEN VETERAN 21+ Years

CHAMPIONSHIP for classes 12- 22 1st & 2nd Prize winners to compete

RING 3

IN HAND CLASSES

Start 9.30am Prompt

Judge

CLASS 23 YOUNGSTOCK any type, 3 years old or under to be split into two sections A) yearlings/ two year olds B) three year olds if large entries

CLASS 24 OPEN any type 4 years old or over to be split into A) Ponies B) horses if large entries

CLASS 25 COLOURED any age or height to be shown in hand. To be split into A) traditional B) Non traditional if large entries

CLASS 26 RETIRED RACEHORSE Any age or height to be shown in hand

CLASS 27 MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND SMALL BREEDS any age, Welsh A & B, Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor

RING THREE CONT.

CLASS 28 MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND LARGE BREEDS any age New Forest, Fell, Dales, Highland, Connemara, Welsh C & D

CLASS 29 FOREIGN BREEDS Any age or height to be shown in hand

CLASS 30 VETERAN 15years and over

CLASS 31 SHOW HORSE / HUNTER any age exceeding 15hh

CLASS 32 PART BRED WELSH / ARAB Any age or height to be shown in hand

CLASS 33 SHOW PONY/ SHOW HUNTER PONY Any age not exceeding 153cms (15hh)

CLASS 34 YOUNG HANDLER

For handlers 16 years and under, judged on presentation, and handling ability, pony must be suitable in size for the handler, all handlers must wear riding hats, No stallions or colts allowed to be split if large entries A) under 12years b) 12 years &over

CHAMPIONSHIP for classes 23 – 34 1st & 2nd Prize winners to compete

RING 4

Start 9.30 Prompt

Judge

CLASS 35 BEGINNERS WORKING HUNTER Fences not to exceed 50 cm. open to all novice combinations that have not won a first prize in working hunter classes

CLASS 36 NOVICE WORKING HUNTER PONY For ponies not exceeding 15hh Fences not to exceed 60 cm Riders must be the correct age for the height of pony

CLASS 37 OPEN WORKING HUNTER PONY For ponies not exceeding 15hh Fences not to exceed 80 cm Riders must be the correct age for the height of pony

CLASS 38 MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND WORKING HUNTER

Jumping section to split into small and large breeds, Fences not to exceed 60cm and 70 cm respectively.

RING 4 CONT.

CLASS 39 NOVICE WORKING HUNTER HORSE For horses exceeding 15hh
Fences not to exceed 60cm

CLASS 40 OPEN WORKING HUNTER HORSE For horses exceeding 15hh
Fences not to exceed 80cm

CHAMPIONSHIP for classes 35 -40 1st & 2nd Prize winners to compete

CLASS 41 PONY CLUB/ RIDING CLUB TYPE

Riders/ horses must show their suitability for pony/ riding club activities, riders will be required to jump a small jump
This class will be split if sufficient entries

RING 5

Judge :-

CLASS 42 MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND LARGE BREEDS RIDDEN

Large Breeds include New Forest, Fell, Dales, Highland, Connemara, Welsh C & D

CLASS 43 MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND SMALL BREEDS RIDDEN

Small breeds include Welsh A & B, Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor

CLASS 44 MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND LEADING REIN

Ponies not exceeding 128cm riders 9 years & under lead reins must be attached to the noseband.

CLASS 45 MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND FIRST RIDDEN

Ponies not exceeding 128cm riders 12 years & under cantering in individual shows only

CHAMPIONSHIP for classes 42- 45 1st & 2nd Prize winners to compete
