**Qualifiers**

**Equifest:**

This Show is affiliated to Equifest, taking place at the East of England Show-ground on the **16th – 19th August 2012**. The **two** highest exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify. **Qualifying classes will have 1 next to them**

**Royal London Show:**

First, second and third placed horses/ponies in eligible classes will qualify for the Champion of Britain Title classes to be held at the Royal London Show in 2012. Each qualified horse/pony will receive a qualification card in the ring which will enable the owner to enter the Royal London Show, provided the owner and rider/handler are, or become registered with the International Showing Society within 28 days of the qualifying show. ### **Qualifiers continued**

#### **TGCA:**

These classes are qualifiers for the TGCA National Championship Show to be held 22nd September 2012 at The College Equestrian Centre, Keysoe, Bedfordshire. TGCA Classes (in hand or ridden) are open to anyone, unless showing a stallion. All stallions four years old and over must be licensed with the TGCA prior to the show. In order to qualify for the TGCA National Championships, all exhibits must be registered (passports overstamped) and exhibitors

and owners must be fully paid up members either prior to, or within 21 days of the show date for that qualification to be valid. Members who are registered prior to the show, must have their qualification cards present in the ring for the judge to sign for the qualification to be valid. **Qualifying classes will have <sup>3</sup> next to them**

#### **TARRA:**

TARRA Ridden: Open to all Weatherby Registered Thoroughbreds raced or not (*passports will be checked*) 4yrs and over, Ideally racing name of horse. Class will be judged as a riding horse without "type", Injuries caused through racing will be overlooked. The first two will qualify and will pass down the line to 4th place only. The judge may ride. This is a qualifier for the TARRA Ridden Championship to be held in September 2012.

TARRA In-Hand: Open to all Weatherby Registered Thoroughbreds raced or not (*passports will be checked*) Any age, Ideally racing name of horse. Class will be judged as a normal In-Hand, Injuries caused through racing will be overlooked. The first two will qualify and will pass down to 4th place only.

This is a qualifier for the TARRA In-Hand Championship to be held in September 2012

#### **Ultimate showcase of champions:**

Qualification for the Ultimate will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup>– 3<sup>rd</sup> placed competitors in each relevant class. **Qualifying classes will have U next to them**

#### **15+ Horse & Pony Events:**

To qualify for the 2012 National Championship Show the first, second and third place horse/pony in the following classes **Qualifying classes will have 15+ next to them** will each Receive a Qualification Card. To enter the National Championship Show the rider/handler and horse/pony must register with 15+ Horse & Pony Events within 21 days of the qualifying show date. **CLASS 2 LEAD REIN BEST RIDER** 9 years and under, lead reins must be Attached to the noseband (all riders will receive a teddy bear when competing in this class) 1st & 2nd prize winners qualify for mini championship (15+)

**CLASS 3 NOVICE RIDER** - for riders in their first year of showing, no cantering except in individual shows. (15+)

**CLASS 4 BEST RIDER 12 YEARS AND UNDER** - To be ridden off the lead rein, not cantering except in individual shows. (15+)

**CLASS 5 BEST RIDER 16 YEARS AND UNDER** (15+)

**CLASS 6 BEST RIDER OPEN** (15+)

**CLASS 7 VETERAN RIDER** - for riders over 40 years a bottle of wine will be awarded to the winner (15+)

**CLASS 8 LEAD REIN COMBINATION** Riders 9 years or under, 1st & 2nd prize winners qualify for mini championship (1<sup>2</sup> U 15+)

**CLASS 9 FIRST RIDDEN COMBINATION** Riders 12 years or under, Cantering in individual shows only,

1st & 2nd prize winners qualify for mini championship (1<sup>2</sup> U 15+)

**CLASS 10 BEST COMBINATION UNDER 16 YEARS** no lead reins (15+)

**CLASS 11 BEST COMBINATION OPEN** (15+)

**RING TWO Start 9am Judge - TBC**

**CLASS 12 NOVICE SHOW HORSE** - Open to all types of show horse not to have won an open showing class prior to 2012 show season

**CLASS 13 HACK /RIDING HORSE** for horses 4 years old or over, Exceeding 15hh (1<sup>2</sup> U 15+)

**CLASS 14 RIDDEN COB including MAXI cob** - for horses 4 years old or over. To be shown trimmed and hogged this class is also open to maxi cobs (1<sup>2</sup> U 15+)

**CLASS 15 OPEN RIDDEN HUNTER including SMALL Hunters** for horses 4 years old or over exceeding 15hh (1<sup>2</sup> U 15+)

**CLASS 16A RIDDEN COLOURED (Plaited)** 4 years or over, to be judged on conformation, manners and turn out. (1<sup>2</sup> U 15+)

**CLASS 16B RIDDEN COLOURED (Non-Plaited)** 4 years or over, to be judged on conformation, manners and turn out. (1<sup>2</sup> U 15+)

**CLASS 17 RIDDEN VETERAN** (2 U 15+)

**CLASS 19 SHOW PONY / SHOW HUNTER** 4 years old or over, Not to exceed 153cm, lead reins permitted ( if lead rein qualifies for the championship, it must enter the mini championship rather than Ring 2 championship) ( <sup>1 2</sup> U 15+)

**CLASS 20 PART BRED RIDDEN** 4 years or over to be judged on conformation, manners and turn out. ( <sup>1 2</sup> U 15+)

**CLASS 21 PURE & FOREIGN BREEDS** Open to any pure breeds foreign or native to UK excluding M&M ( <sup>2</sup> U 15+)

**CLASS 22 BEST RIDDEN GELDING** – to be judged on way of going and Individual show, lead reins permitted ( if lead rein qualifies for the championship, it must enter the mini championship rather than Ring 2 championship)

**CLASS 23 BEST RIDDEN MARE** – to be judged on way of going and Individual show, lead reins permitted ( if lead rein qualifies for the championship, it must Enter the mini championship rather than Ring 2 championship)

**CLASS 29 RIDDEN THOROUGHBRED** – raced or unraced, will not be ridden by the judge ( <sup>2</sup> U 15+)

**CLASS 30 RIDDEN TARRA QUALIFIER** - Open to all Weatherby Registered Thoroughbreds raced or not ( passports will be checked) Any age, Ideally racing name of horse. Class will be judged as a normal In-Hand, Injuries caused through racing will be overlooked. The first two will qualify and will pass down to 4th place only. This is a qualifier for the TARRA In-Hand Championship at Equifest August 2012

**CLASS 47 IN HAND COLOURED (Plaited)** any age, to be judged on conformation, manners and turn out. ( <sup>1 2</sup> U 15+)

**CLASS 48 IN HAND COLOURED (Non-Plaited)** any age, to be judged on conformation, manners and turn out. ( <sup>1 2</sup> U 15+)

**CLASS 49 PART BREEDS IN HAND** - open to part bred horses and ponies, any height, age. ( <sup>2</sup> U 15+)

**CLASS 50 SHOW PONY/ SHOW HUNTER PONY IN HAND** Any age not exceeding 153cms (15hh) ( <sup>1 2</sup> U 15+)
